



Overview: The NJLN Scholarship Program is designed to aid with the nursing education of our members. This supports our organization's goal to promote nursing excellence through continuing education. Our scholarship program is constructed to meet the diverse needs of our members to provide the opportunity for support and to recognize the commitment and importance of education at all levels.

Scholarship Eligibility:

- The applicant must:
 - Be a legal resident of the United States.
 - Be a permanent in-state resident of New Jersey.
 - Be enrolled in an accredited nursing program.
 - Have completed one of the following:
 - Acceptance into a practical nursing program and provide proof of registration
 - One clinical course in a nursing program that prepares graduates for practice as a registered nurse (Diploma, ADN, BSN)
 - One semester in an accredited nursing program. (MSN, Doctorate)
 - Applicant must be a current member of the New Jersey League for Nursing. Visit www.njln.org for membership details, or [join now - click here](#).
- Evidence of academic ability:
 - Transcripts from the institution currently enrolled (must include the most recent semester completed).
 - Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or greater.
- Complete the required New Jersey League for Nursing (NJLN) 2023 Scholarship Application form.
- Provide one written character reference from a current or previous nursing instructor/professor.
- Submit an essay explaining how you plan to advance the health of the patients, families, or communities where you will be practicing.
- You are **not** eligible to apply if you have previously been awarded a scholarship from the NJLN Scholarship Program within the past 3 years.
 - Note: Applicants may apply for a scholarship after the 3-year period if it is in pursuit of a different degree. It cannot for the same degree you were awarded a scholarship for from the NJLN previously.

How do I apply?

To apply for a scholarship, you must be an active member of the New Jersey League for Nursing (NJLN) and meet all of the criteria, and submit all of the required information and documents to be considered.

The 2024 Scholarships available will be in the amount of \$1,000 each.

◆ Specific to a diploma Registered Nurse pursuing a BSN Degree

◆ Specific to those pursuing a BSN Degree

Helen Marie Dolton Nursing Education Scholarship

◆ Specific to those pursuing their MSN, DNP, PhD with the intent to be a nurse educator

Jack Robertson Memorial Scholarship

◆ Open to all levels of nursing education

Raymond J. Santee Memorial Scholarship

◆ Specific to a pre-licensure student, preferably in a diploma or ADN program
